Responsibilities of a Trainer

- Participate in Pre-plan meeting.
 - Be involved in the division of responsibilities and topics.
 - Agreement on time designation and activities for presentations and segments
- Be thoroughly prepared.
- "Fill in the gaps" on presentations.
- Come up with activities to increase participants' comprehension.
- Engage and encourage audience participation.
- Be clear and concise with your presentation.
- Support other presenters.
- Be flexible and respond to needs throughout the training.
- Demonstrate understanding of licensing standards, CMHC regulations.
- Cover content in training manual
- Be professional.
- Above all, you have to have a strong belief in the Strengths Based Philosophy and be able to apply it to all that you do. It is the foundation of the trainings, Case Management, and Community Based Services.
