Facilitating the Wrap-Around Meeting

Waiver Rules

- It is the responsibility of the Wrap-Around Team to develop an individualized Plan of Care for the child on the Waiver.
- A full Wrap-Around Team meeting for the initial meeting for a youth participating in the SED or PRTF Waivers is required. A list of Wrap-Around Team members and their level of involvement at the initial Wrap-Around meeting must be included in the POC. Review meetings should also include the list of participants on the Wrap-Around Team and their level of involvement.)
- The Wrap-Around Facilitator's job is to guide the process related to the development of the Plan of Care.
- The role of the Wrap-Around Facilitator differs from all other roles on the team.
- The Wrap-Around Facilitator ensures that the Four Core Values of HCBS Waiver Services are honored.
- The Wrap-Around Facilitator is charged with making sure that Waiver rules are followed.
- When a change is made on the Waiver Plan of Care, the change needs to be communicated to the individuals who file the electronic plan.
