

Wrap-Around Facilitation Training Post Meeting Responsibilities

Waiver Rules

Let's review some of the rules established by the Waiver for this phase of the process:

- The POC can be reviewed at any time if you, the family or other team members believe there is a need.
- If you serve in both roles of CPST provider and WAF you often will be switching hats – doing both jobs. As you do so keep in mind that Wrap-Around Facilitation, and Wrap-Around Facilitator responsibilities, are established by the Waiver as a separate and unique service. You cannot bill for CPST services at the same time you are acting as Wrap-Around Facilitator. For example if you are facilitating the Wrap-Around Meeting and make input as the CPST provider, you only can bill as the WAF.
- An annual Wrap-Around Meeting and an Annual Evaluation of the need for HCBS Waiver Services is required. The clinician (QMHP) responsible for the Plan of Care is also responsible for the annual evaluation. As the WAF, you need to check and ensure the annual evaluation takes place. The date for completion is the month of the annual anniversary of the date of initial clinical eligibility.
